

**Walton & Frinton YC**  
**H2 and Phantom Open Meeting, 3-4 October 2020**  
**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1. Organising Authority**

1.1 The Organising Authority is Walton and Frinton Yacht Club.

**2. Venue**

2.1 Walton and Frinton Yacht Club, Mill Lane, Walton-on-the-Naze, CO14 8PF

2.2 The H2 and Phantom Open Event will be held on Saturday 3rd and Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2020.

**3. Rules**

3.1 The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017 - 2020, the prescriptions of the RYA, appropriate Class Rules and the Sailing Instructions for the event.

**4. Eligibility**

4.1 Competition for the H2s shall be confined to members of the H2 Class Association.

4.2 All competitors must have completed an entry form for the event and paid the required fee before the preparatory signal for the first race of the series.

**5. Advertising**

5.1 The event is designated category C in accordance with ISAF Reg. 20

**6. Registration**

6.1 Competitors can enter the event by completing an entry form available from [simonhipkinboats@gmail.com](mailto:simonhipkinboats@gmail.com) for the H2s, together with the required entry fee. Alternatively, competitors can enter on the day of the event at the registration desk at Walton and Frinton Yacht Club (additional fee applicable, see below)

6.2 Registration for the event will commence at 09:00 on Saturday 3rd October 2020 at Walton and Frinton Yacht Club.

**7. Fees**

7.1 The entry fee for the event is £20 for. An additional fee of £5 per boat will be charged for entries received after the 2nd October 2020.

**8. Racing Area and Sailing Programme**

8.1 Racing will be conducted within the designated race area. This will be briefed out to competitors before the fleets will be released from shore on both days.

8.2 The event will consist of five races.

8.2.1 Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> October Briefing 10,00. Race 1: First warning signal no earlier than 1055, subsequent races to follow as directed by the PRO.

8.2.2 Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> October Briefing 10.00 First warning signal 11.25, subsequent races to follow as directed by PRO

8.3 One extra race may be sailed on the first day of the event, although the number of races in the series will be no more than five.

8.4 All boats must stay outside the line of sunken barges forming the sea defence on the North East corner of Horsey Island.

## **9. Scoring System**

- 9.1 The event shall be decided in accordance with RRS Appendix A Low Points System.
- 9.2 If four or more races are completed one discard will be allowed. If less than four races are completed no discard will be allowed.

## **10. Sailing Instructions**

- 10.1 Sailing instructions (SI) will be emailed out to competitors after receipt of a completed Entry Form and the . Entry Fee

## **11. Insurance**

- 11.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum of £3,000,000 Third Party liability

## **12. Accommodation**

- 12.1 Limited campervan parking is available on site by the prior agreement of Walton and Frinton Yacht Club, via the nominated contact points, is required

## **13. Social Arrangements**

- 13.1 All competitors will be required to comply with the social distancing requirements that are in force during the event

## **14. Access Information**

- 14.1 Walton and Frinton Yacht Club will be open on the evening of Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October for those wishing to arrive before the event.

- 14.2 Please be advised that the galley and bar will be open throughout the event.
